A. Robotics Club: “Battlebots Competition”

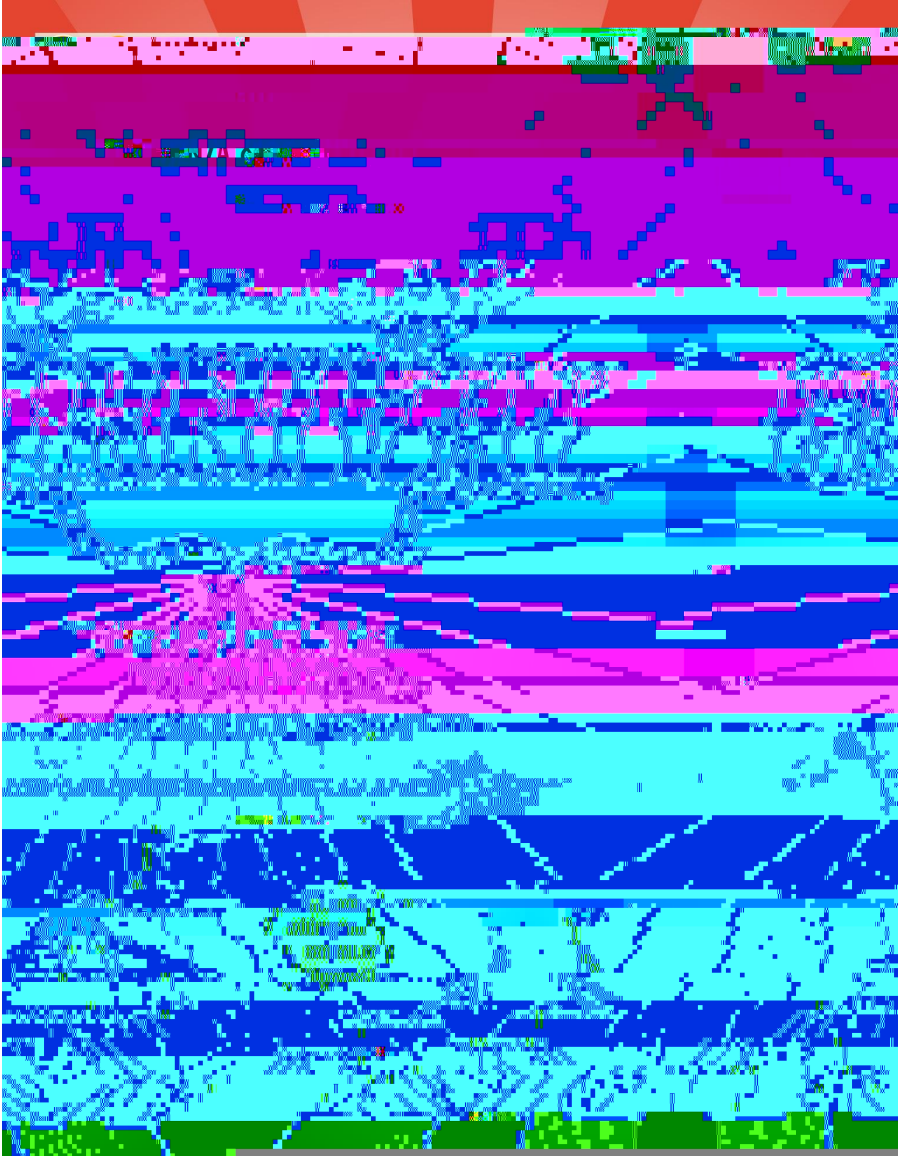
