Apprenticeship: Murphy shared working on Foothill GE applications for two additional degree programs. Allen shared the BS degree proposal has been resubmitted to the CCCC.

Acknowledged that students can take these courses as elective units, but believes it's worthwhile to include in GE. Also acknowledged this would mean higher total units for GE. Brannvall asked if Lifelong Learning could be included as optional GE area—Gilstrap thinks if it's optional, majority of students won't do it.

Parikh noted Foothill GE doesn't apply to transfer degrees but does apply to local degrees; there is no Engineering ADT and probably never will be, so those students are working on local AS degree. Concerned that adding extra requirements could result in these students not completing AS degree before they transfer. Parikh also noted that not requiring Lifelong Learning courses doesn't mean they need to stop being offered. Asked if research has been done to find out if students are taking Lifelong Learning courses outside of GE—

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optional necessarily means student won't take it. Jackson Sandoval asked if there will be student voice in making these decisions—Kaupp responded, this is a very good point and there should be. Noted CCC will be making recommendations on decisions, likely gathering input from Academic Senate, Faculty Association, and student reps. Hueg clarified, CCC will be making the decisions. Kaupp noted has received questions from other colleges about our plans, especially
