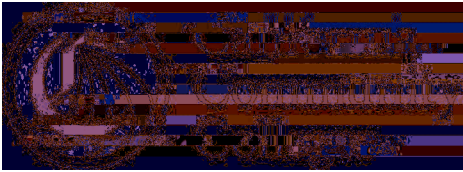

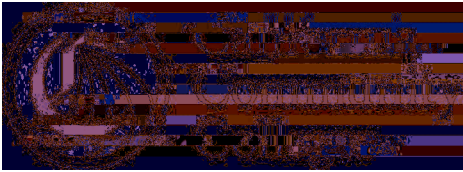


Campus leaders must host open dialogue and address campus climate

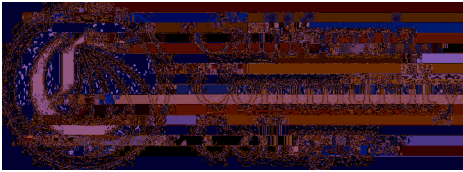

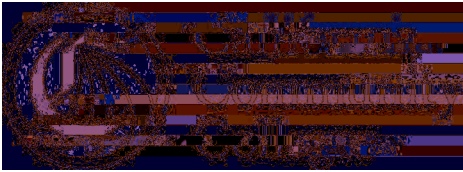
