## **Resolution For the Discontinuance of TracDat**

Whereas, Foothill College first implemented TracDat in 2011 for student learning outcome identification, creation, assessment, and reflection purposes;<sup>1</sup>

Whereas, the annual cost of the TracDat system is upwards of \$11,000;

Whereas, studies have shown that the traditional SLO assessment method in TracDat is ineffective,<sup>2</sup> given that current practice of assessing student learning outcomes using TracDat does not involve control metrics, and thus results in the drawing of invalid conclusions;

Whereas, faculty have overwhelmingly expressed dissatisfaction with the TracDat system for learning outcome evaluation and updates to the Foothill Inquiries team, and this dissatisfaction spans across the higher education arena;<sup>3</sup>

Whereas, TracDat has not been used consistently over the past two years at Foothill;

Whereas, the college learning management system can be used to document and assess learning outcomes at no additional cost, and in a manner that promotes collaboration and a culture of inquiry;

**Whereas**, the Foothill Inquiries team and the office of instruction will download all existing TracDat data prior to discontinuance;

**Resolved**, that the Academic Senate approves the movement of learning outcome activities to the college learning management system, and

**Resolved**, that the Academic Senate approves the discontinuance of TracDat and nonrenewal and the contract with Nuventive.
