Getting a California Driver License

To Qualify:

- x You must be 18 years or older.
- x Be in lawful FI status and a current Foothill Student.
- x Have a local address on file with the ISP Office.
- x Arrival information must be in the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) database. We recommend waiting at least 3 weeks after you arrive in the US.

Required Documents:

- x Passport and visa
- x I-20
- x I-94
- x Two residency documents (this can include a letter from the Foothill ISP Office)
 Residency Ocuments List
- x If you have a Social Security Number (SSN), you need to include it with your application.

Steps to apply:

Before your DMV appointment

- 1. Study for the written testCalifornia Driver Handbook
- 2. Schedulæn appointmenton the DMV welsite hereor by calling 4800-777-0133.
- 3. Complete online application

At the DMV

- 1. Provide documents and pay fees.
- Follow instructions of DMV representative. (fingerprints, vision, tpisture)
- 3. Take your written test.

Taking your driving test (if applicable)

1. Schedule an appointment the <u>DMV website here</u>or by calling 4800-777-0133.

Receiving your driver's license

You will receive a temporary driver's license valid for 60 days while you wait for your actual driver's license to arrive in the mail. If you do not receive your driver's license in 60 days, please002777-0133.

- x If you purchase or own a car, you are required to register your car with the DMV. This registration must be renewed every year.
