In the past academic year, 407 Foothill students transferred to a CSU while 483 transferred to an UC institution. The total transfers decreased from 2017-18 to 2018-19. This trend represents a 10% decrease in the number of fall-to-fall transfer students (Table 1). Transfers to the UC system continue to exceed those transferring to the CSUs, 2017-18 notwithstanding.

Out of the 407 students transferring to a CSU institution, the largest representation was at San Jose State University (213), followed by San Francisco State (81) and Cal State East Bay (32). Chico State (14) and Cal Poly Pomona (11) represent the remaining top five CSU transfer destinations among Foothill students (Table 2). Compared to 2017-18, the number of transfer students to these five institutions decreased from 425 students to 351. The number of transfer students to these five institutions increased from 351 in 2017-18 to 425 in 2018-19.

Below are the 2018-19

Table 9 lists the top four in-state private universities and colleges enrolling the highest numbers of Foothill transfers in 2018-19. With the exception of the University of Southern California, these institutions are located in the Bay Area.
