### What is Foothill Promise Program?

First-time, full-time students eligible to have the cost of tuition, fees and textbooks fully paid for their first two years at Foothill (except summer)

Not to be confused with the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as BOG fee waiver)

#### What are the program parameters?

- Students must remain enrolled full-time
- Beginning Fall 2020, this stipulation was dropped
- Students can return to Promise after stopping out or dropping down to part-time
- But 2-year eligibility begins the first year of enrollment

# How does Foothill operate its Promise Program?

- As an access opportunity
- Supports are financial (fees, course materials)
- No programmatic components


