









More Key Results

\$6.00 is the overall change in hourly wages after completing training—in dollars 32% is the overall change in hourly wages after completing training—in percentage gain 66% of respondents reported being employed for pay

9% of respondents reported transferring to another college or university

91% of respondents reported being very satisfied or satisfied with their training.

## Conclusion

The results of the survey showed that completing CTE studies and training – whether or not a credential is earned, whether or not a student transfers – is related to positive employment outcomes. The preponderance of respondents are employed and are working in the same field as their studies or training. Notably, students realize a greater wage gain after completing their studies if they secure a job that is similar to their program of study.
