RE: 2020-21 Four Year Transfer Mombers

Overview

The 202021 transfer data, identified from the California State University Chancellor's Office, University of California Office of the President, and California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, are analyzed to present a report about the transfer rate and patterns to the CSU and UC systems as wellsathe instate private and out of-state institutions.

Highlights:

- x The number of transfers to the in-state public system, CSUs and UCsrelesed by 5% from 2019-20 to 2020-21. This decrease was drivery a 9%decrease in CSU transfers; the number of transfers to UCs remained stable (443 vs..445)
- x Thenumber of transfer**s**to in-state privateand out-of-state institutions increased by 5% between 2019-20 and 2020-21 (ISP6%; OoS: **%**).
- x Latinx(29%)and Asian (25%)students represent the majority of those transferring to the CSU system in 2020, while White students represent roughly ne-fifth of all CSU transfer students 2(1%).
- x The acceptance rate to the UC system in 2020vas 77%, with 73% of those admitted going on to enroll
- x The largest number of UC transfers in 2022/0enrolled at UCSan Diego(84), UCSanta Cruz (77), and UC Davi(68).
- x Compared tots eightneighboring community colleges, Foothill had the baghest total number of students transferred to CSUs

California Public Fourfear Transfers

In the past academic year, 456 othill students transferred to a CSU while 443 ferred to an UC institution. While transfers remained stable to the UC system, transferthe CSU system decreased from 2019-20 to 2020-21 by 9% Overall, there was 5% decrease in the number of annual transfer students a UC or CS(Table 1)
