Dear Colleagues,

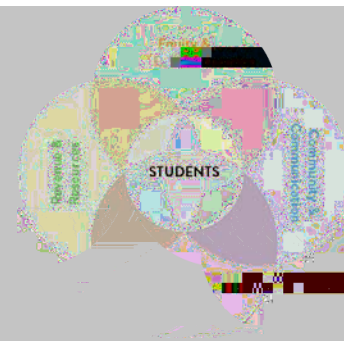

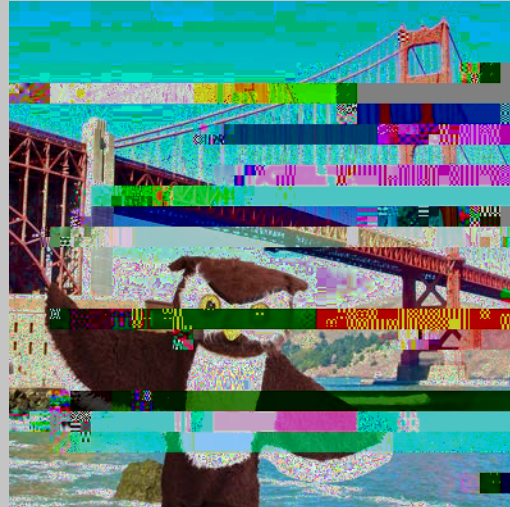
