We continue to monitor five levels of academic and progress probation. However, faculty and staff may also identify potentially at-risk students via interactions in the classroom or elsewhere on campus.

We currently direct students needing additional support to online resources like EdReady and Smarthinking, and provide supplemental instruction and general academic assistance through on-campus resources such as the PSME Center, the Teaching and Learning Center, Disability Resource Center, Veterans' Resource Center, Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE), and Extended Opportunities Program and Services (EOPS)
