For example, about onefourth of the Sound & Communication (APSC) program students have previously earned a degree (associate and higher)onworkers (APIW) is primarily Latino (64%) and not White (28%) enrollment. Pipe Trades, Sheet Metal, Field Ironworkers (APPR) has declined in enrollment by 20%; enrollment decline is also seen in APSIC%). Additional explanation would be helpful in supporting the statement in the rogram review document that "the job outlook has been the best since the boom of the late 1980s.


