Noncredit Certificate in English as a Second Language—Intermediate

Program Goals and Objectives

Students will demonstrate aural, written, and spoken English literacy at increasingly more complex levels of expression, culminating in their ability to start credit ESL courses.

Units required for Certificate: 360 hours

Catalog Description

This certificate prepares students to advance to credit levels of ESL, and provides the foundations for students to meet the requirements of an Associate Degree. Students will be exposed to integrated skills courses for learners of English as an additional language, and learn such practical skills such as: demonstrate understanding of spoken English at the intermediate level, communicate using intermediate level English, speak intelligibly, ask and answer questions intelligibly, talk about present, past and future experiences intelligibly, read sentences and paragraphs at the intermediate level,
