An act to amend Sections 70901.5 and 71092 of the Education Code, relating to community colleges.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest**

SB 1062, as introduced, Liu. California Community Colleges: board of governors.

Existing law establishes the California Community Colleges, under the administration of the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, as one of the segments of public postsecondary education in this state. Existing law prohibits the board of governors from adopting regulations that the Department of Finance determines w

The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state. Statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement.

This bill would provide that, if the Commission on State Mandates determines that the bill contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement for those costs shall be made pursuant to these statutory provisions.
