NEWS:

- ! The following courses were approved on January 17th for Foothill GE for 2012-13:
Area I, Humanities - SPAN 13A, 13B, 14A & 14B.
Area III, Natural Sciences - BIOL 10, HORT 10.
Area IV, Social & Behavioral Sciences - POLI 9H, SPED 62.
- ! The following courses received Stand Alone approval on January 17th: ENGR 600, MUS 2F/THTR 2F, NCBS 403, 404, 405, NCEL 403A, 403B.
- ! The Counseling Division is exploring the possibility of creating a counseling degree. If anyone has suggestions regarding a particular focus, please contact the Counseling Division CCC Reps, Isaac Escoto and/or Andy Lee.
- ! CCC approved a resolution to establish a process for the development of new courses to help ensure transparency. A short form will be developed by the CCC Team to assist faculty and CCC Reps in sharing the necessary information in the CCC, and this will be required before faculty may receive a new C3MS shell.
