The State Chancellor's Office has provided some information regarding the proposed changes to the repetition and repeatability language in title 5. Must revise our CORs no later than Fall 2012 in order for the changes to become effective Fall 2013.

- Repeatability for disability students: repeat is possible as long as the course is specifically designed for students with disabilities, not a "regular" course that accommodates a student with disabilities.
- Leveling of courses: language unclear about whether quarter schools may have 4 levels, or six levels (language says six times). CH/KM to get clarification from Chancellor's Office. Important to note that withdrawals and failed attempts count against the six "times." Will clarify and bring back.
- 55041: talks about those courses that are repeatable based on UC/CSU requirements - clarification that if UC/CSU requires a course to be repeated, we can also allow the course to
