

Foothill College Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Spring 2015 and Spring 2016

x Enrollment

- o Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is ~~up~~ at 143,121.
- o Total headcount is ~~up~~ at 12,434.
- o Resident estimated WSCH is ~~up~~ at 117,883.
- o Non-resident estimated WSCH is ~~down~~ at 25,238.

x Online Learning

- o Total online learning estimated WSCH is ~~up~~ at 47,206.
- o Online learning headcount is ~~up~~ 5% from 6,339 to 6,655.
- o Online learning enrollment is ~~up~~ from 9,404 to 9,688.
- o Online learning sections offered is

x Student Population

- o The largest increase in headcount (178) occurred among first time transfer students while the largest increase in estimated FTEs (+9) occurred among first time new students.
- o From Spring 2015 and Spring 2016, enrollment among returning students from continued to increase (10) while a decline in headcount (-51) while a decline in FTEs (-1%) occurred among continuing students.

x Zip Code Grouping

- o Enrollment decreased from "Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga" (7%) and "San Mateo County" (6%).
- o The largest percentage

x Zip Code Grouping by Student Residency

- o Resident student enrollment declined from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (198) and “San Mateo County” (89) from Spring 2015 and Spring 2016
- o Resident students from “San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward, East Palo Alto” had the largest increase by headcount (+230).

x Zip Code Grouping within Santa Clara County

- o Within Santa Clara County, African American student enrollment decreased among those from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (5%) between Spring 2015 (99) and Spring 2016 (94).
- o Within Santa Clara County, Filipino student enrollment increased by the largest percentage (16%) in “San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward, East Palo Alto” between Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 (304 to 353).
- o Within Santa Clara County, Latino student enrollment increased except among those from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (557 to 540).

x International Students (F1)

- o Enrollment among F1 students increased from Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 by 5%, from 1,260 to 1,197.
- o Females represented 41% of all international students (F1 and FZ visa holders) in Spring 2016 compared to 39% in Spring 2015 (+2%)
- o In Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 the top three countries of origin for international students included China (S15: 416 vs. S16: 433), Hong Kong (S15: 148 vs. S16: 124) and Indonesia (S15: 145 vs. S16: 101). These 3 countries of origin represent 55% of all F1 student enrollment.

x Applicants who Registered in Spring 2016

- o Almost half of the Spring 2016 applicants registered for the fall term (48%).

- o One-fifth of the applicants who registered reported that they were never involved in activities that served the community in the past year (20), which is down 1% from Spring 2015.

- o About onethird of the applicants who registered reported that they were first generation college students (31%), which is up 2% from Spring 2015
