RE: International Student (F1) Enrollment Trends

---

### Overview

Students with F1 visa status and whose nation of citizenship is China, Turkey or Vietnam were identified to determine the enrollment trends from these countries over the last two years. Table 1 shows the enrollment trends for the past two fall terms. While both China and Turkey have seen an increase in enrollment from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012, enrollment from Vietnam has declined by 11% at both colleges during the same time period.

Table 1. F1 Student Enrollment from China, Turkey and Vietnam, Fall 2011 and Fall 2012.

### Methodology

Data extracted for the Open Doors report was used to identify F1 status students. Note that for Fall 2012, there were 39 additional students with other visa status from China and Vietnam (34 at De Anza and 5 at Foothill).
