<u>Overview</u>

Students who enrolled in Non-Credit Parenting (NCP) courses in 2012 were identified to determine how many NCP courses they enrolled in and whether they enrolled in for credit courses. Table 1 shows that 761 students enrolled in a NCP course and about half of these students enrolled in at least two NCP courses during 2012 (51%).
