RE: Full-time and Part-time Headcount

Overview

The number of unique students enrolled each quarter during 2012-13 was identified and disaggregated by enrollment status. Table 1 shows the headcount by full-time (>12 units) and part-time status (<12 units). While students attempting less than six units account for the majority of enrollment during both summer terms, their headcount is comparable to their full-time peers during the academic year.

Methodology

Headcount based on data reported at census and students are counted once within each term. Students attempting less than 12 units in one term are part-time while those attempting more than 12 units are full-time. These figures do not include Apprenticeship.
