
Background

Skillsbuildingstudentsfrom Foothill Collegewere surveyed they met one of the following criteria in 2010 2011, and did not enroll in 2011 2012: earned a certificate of 6 or more units, earned a vocational degree, or earned 9+CTE units. The survey was administered in early 2013 first by e mail, then by USmail. The surveyaddressed student perceptions of their CTE program, employment outcomes, and how their coursework and training relate to their current career.

Thesampleconsisted 1,838 unduplicated students,133 of whom responded by e mail (7%), 128 by USmail (7%) for a total responserate of 14%.

- Results
- Respondentswere askedtheir primary reasonfor studying at Foothill College and half (49%) indicated earning a certificate or degree (with or without transfer). Figure 1 shows the results.

Primary reasonfor studying




- Respondentswere askedwhy they stoppedtaking classes at Foothill College. Here are the most frequently cited reasons in rank order of frequency:
- 9 My goalswere met (105)
- 9 I completed the program (100)
- 9 I got a job (53)
- 9 I transferredto anotherschool(39)
- 9 Classes neededwere not available (35) to a pursue

Bachelor's Degree.

77% of respondents employed for pay. Figure 2 shows the results.
