## <u>Overview</u>

To help ASFC project we from student body fees, data was gathered that identified how many students paid fees in the Spring 2011, Summer 2011, Fall 2011 and Winter 2012 terms.

Table 1 shows the student enrollment by quarter and the number of students who were to pay fees. It appears that approximately 90% of enrolled students were charged fees.
