RE: Transfer Celebration 2016 Demographics

Overview

Students participating in the annual Transfer Celebration were identified their demographic information was analyzed. There were 74 students in attendance.

Highlights

- Over half of the student participants were of Asian or White ethn (617%)
- Females represented the majority of participa (658%)
- Majority of the students are traditional aged transfer students, under age 290%)
- Majority of the studentswere not awarded financial aid in 20156 (65%)
- Less than half of the student participants of F-1 visastatus (42%)

Table 1 shows the participation disaggregated by (seplorted) ethnicity. While the "decline to state" group appears to represent roughly of seurth of the students, closer analysis indicates that these individuals have F1 visastatus (n=20) and they may be Asian (n=11) Latino/a (n=3) or White (n=3) Such a result would suggest that east three-fourths of the student participants are either Asian or White (76%).

The gender breakdown roughly reflects the overall collegeulation, where females represent 53% of Fall 2015 credit enrollmenthe Transfer Celebration partipants are more likely to female (58% vs. 42%) (Table 2).
